

# IL RISTORANTE – NIKO ROMITO AT BVLGARI RESORT BALI



*Il Ristorante – Niko Romito Bali*

*Bali, April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026* - Opened in May 2025, **Il Ristorante – Niko Romito Bali** introduces a distinctly measured interpretation of Italian dining to Bvlgari Resort Bali. Perched on the limestone cliffs of Uluwatu, it is the only outpost within the Bvlgari Hotels & Resorts collection set against an uninterrupted ocean view, with the horizon present throughout the evening.

The restaurant accommodates a scale that shapes the intimate experience with only 24 seats. The dining space is arranged around a still reflection pool, with lighting kept deliberately low. There is a single service each evening, allowing the pace to remain consistent and unhurried.



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Developed in collaboration with **three-Michelin-starred Chef Niko Romito**, the cuisine follows a clear direction. Italian tradition is not reinterpreted for effect, but examined and reduced to its essential structure. The focus remains on definition of flavour, with technique applied only where it serves that purpose.

*“True flavor is an absolute value, and as such it can speak to everyone, both to a foreigner and an Italian. Food is naturally a total experience that extends well beyond what’s on the plate. It’s a question of atmosphere, attention, refinement, and above all, well-being. At Bvlgari Hotels & Resorts, guests are welcomed into a world of relaxed, natural luxury. I wanted to reproduce this atmosphere at Il Ristorante – Niko Romito through a cuisine made of authentic Italian flavors and iconic dishes; a service that encourages conviviality and tells a story about the Italian relationship with food,”* says Chef Niko Romito.

In Bali, the menu reflects a considered use of local ingredients, shaped within the direction of Chef Niko Romito’s signature approach. Selected preparations incorporate seafood sourced daily, Kintamani vanilla, Plaga tomatoes, and seasonal vegetables, alongside herbs cultivated within the resort. These elements are introduced with precision, allowing Bali-inspired expressions to develop within the framework of Chef Niko Romito’s cuisine without altering its Italian foundation.

The format is structured around **tasting menus** offered in both shorter and extended sequences, available to all guests, including those visiting the resort for the evening. For those staying at Bvlgari Resort Bali, an **à la carte selection** provides an alternative approach, allowing the experience to adjust across different moments of a stay.

The kitchen is led by Chef de Cuisine Francesca Stabile, who oversees the execution of the concept in Bali. As the only female chef within the Bvlgari Hotels & Resorts collection to hold this position, her role brings a distinct clarity to the restaurant’s direction. She works under the guidance of Executive Chef Alessandro Mazzali, maintaining a consistent approach across each service.
