### OVERVIEW AND DESTINATION

The Bvlgari Hotel Milano is a unique and extraordinary jewel. Its suggestive and strategic location, the contemporary design by the renowned architectural firm Antonio Citterio and Patricia Viel, and extreme attention to detail, ensure the complete well-being of guests, making this hotel an icon of luxury just like all the creations of the Maison.

Opened in 2004, the Bvlgari Hotel Milano was the first in the collection, marking the entry of Bvlgari - a leading luxury brand - into the world of hospitality. Today, there are nine Bvlgari Hotels & Resorts, located in the cities of Milan, London, Bali, Beijing, Dubai, Shanghai, Paris, Tokyo and Rome, including the restaurants in Tokyo and Osaka. The Bvlgari Resort Ranfushi in the Maldives will be the tenth jewel of the collection, followed by the opening of Miami Beach and Bodrum in 2026.

Nestled in a 4,000 sqm private garden, near the ancient Botanical Garden, the Bvlgari Hotel Milano is located in the heart of Brera, a fancy neighborhood of discreet elegance, home to many treasures of the Milanese cultural heritage such as the Accademia di Belle Arti, the church of Santa Maria del Carmine and the Teatro alla Scala, known as the world temple of opera. The hotel features 61 rooms, including 17 suites, most overlooking the stunning garden, one of the rare green oases of tranquility in the historic center of the city.

With a staff of around 170 employees, under the guidance of General Manager Goffredo Dell'Appennino, the Bvlgari Hotel Milano offers an experience of natural well-being and hospitality, ensuring an unforgettable stay.

#### ORIGINS OF THE SITE

The Bvlgari Hotel Milano is housed in a historic building dating back to the 18th century, a former convent of the Sisters of the Cenacle confraternity. Part of the original façade has been preserved and can still be admired today.

In 1813, both the building and the surrounding garden became the property of the Milanese family Lucini Passalacqua, who established their residence there. The earliest information on the original layout of the garden is found in the "Ruralium Commodorum" by Piero de Crescenza, a document of 1305 that testifies the existence of a large garden-veranda and a greenhouse for rare plants. Until the beginning of the 20th century, the garden hosted concerts and receptions for painting enthusiasts.

The garden was entrusted to Sophie Agata Ambroise, a sensitive Swiss landscape architect who created an environment-friendly design, attentive to the local biodiversity.

The Bvlgari Hotel Milano is located in a private street in the financial and cultural center of the city, surrounded by historic buildings that hide art treasures and enchanting courtyards behind their austere facades. A few steps away is the so-called “Quadrilatero della moda”, stretching from Via Montenapoleone to Via della Spiga, which hosts a high concentration of the most iconic fashion boutiques, jewelers, showrooms, design and furniture ateliers.

#### DISTINCTIVE FEATURES

What sets the Bvlgari Hotel Milano apart is the delicate balance between the rigorous design of the space and the elegant atmosphere achieved through the use of heavy and imposing materials such as black Zimbabwe marble and bronze. The building dates back to the 1950s and reflects in its graphic look the design tradition of its era, perfectly blending into the elegant style of the street, built up over the past thirty years. The white marble façade creates a refined and light mood that contrasts with the massive design of the nearby stone buildings. The windows, with black granite frames outlined in stained oak, stand out as a visual counterpoint to the restored 18th-century part of the facade.

As guests approach the building, they can already glimpse the garden through a wall of lush vegetation. The narrow and high windows of the lobby overlook the entrance court with a high sliding door, sheltered by a massive cantilevered bronze roof. The mirrored glass reflects the garden in a play of infinite references, while transparent panels reveal the majestic sequence of the five-meter-high interiors. The use of black granite and Burmese teak wood create an elegant yet informal environment, perfectly in tune with the garden, itself an extension of the interiors. In contrast to the glass façade, the very dark color of the granite gives the interiors a monumental character. In the lounge, images from the Bvlgari archives frame the walk towards the other rooms, adding a touch of history and prestige to the environment.

#### PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SPACES

The key elements of the classic yet contemporary design by the renowned architecture studio Antonio Citterio and Patricia Viel, with cream-colored wallpaper, furniture from Antonio Citterio's Flexform collection and Maxalto, drapes by Enzo degli Angiuoni, B&B modular bookcases and Altai carpets. Framed sketches of iconic Bvlgari jewels decorate all the rooms, while the suites feature a collection of art and design books.

In the public spaces, archive sketches from the 1950s of Bvlgari's famed "spille Giardinetto" – or garden brooches – hang next to the elevators. In the lobby, large portraits of celebrities who have been iconic ambassadors or loyal clients of the Roman High Jewelry Maison, such as Monica Vitti, Sophia Loren and Anita Ekberg, enrich the environment.

The restaurant area surprises with the unusual structure of its lenticular ceiling suspended on a large oval balcony in black resin, which overlooks the terrace and the garden, for a unique scenic effect.

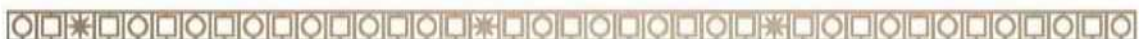
In the Spa, the use of exceptional materials such as the Vicenza stone, laid in irregular patterns, the green glass-panes and the breathtaking swimming pool with gold mosaic, creates a contemporary and rigorous aesthetic. At the same time, the design suggests an atmosphere of oriental relaxation that fits perfectly to an area dedicated to well-being.

In the corridors, the black and saffron color scheme of the communal areas is rendered with the use of graphite-stained oak, saffron carpet and linen tapestries on the walls. The thick and massive room doors guarantee absolute acoustic insulation, while providing a view of the garden that's accompanied by a silence which is almost unreal in Milan's city center.

All the rooms are organized in a logical sequence of spaces, from the perfectly functional entrance to the more private areas of the bathroom looking onto the garden. Here, the pale color of bleached oak prevails, whose warm and soft shades create a striking contrast with the black granite of the bathtub and the travertine of the shower.

Located on the top floor of the hotel, the Bvlgari Suite is a quiet haven, spacious and intimate at the same time. Its completely transparent façade creates an open space on the garden with spectacular views of the city. The design concept, inspired by the idea of an urban villa, is strengthened by the use of teak flooring that blend the interiors and outdoor spaces. The living room is dominated by a monumental fireplace in Brera stone, while the bathroom, with its bathtub cut from a single block of Turkish Bihara stone, recalls oriental hammams. Highlight of the Bvlgari Suite is the rooftop garden with a 360-degree view of the Milan skyline. This 145 square meter outdoor space, ideal for enjoying both day and night, includes a relaxation area furnished with chaise longues and sofas, as well as a dining area completely surrounded by greenery.

Ultimate attention to detail is what sets the Bvlgari Hotel Milano apart - a true example of immersive design. From the door handles to the entire façade, from every single piece of furniture to the desk accessories, glass and fabrics, every detail and element has been expressly studied, created and implemented. The result is an extraordinarily consistent design that makes the environment particularly harmonious: form and substance integrate perfectly in an overall feeling of absolute and uncompromising quality.

## GUESTROOMS AND SUITES

The 61 rooms, including 17 suites, offer guests of the Bvlgari Hotel Milano the extraordinary opportunity to enjoy an unexpected sense of tranquility right in the heart of the city. Large windows offer splendid views of the charming garden or the courtyard of a historic Milanese palazzo. The furnishings and interior finishes have been designed to be in harmony with the surrounding landscape, thanks to the use of light woods such as teak and oak, which contrast with the dark corridors, creating a refined and enveloping atmosphere.

The feeling offered by each guestroom is that of being in a private residence, in an intimate space, even before entering the room. The doors to the rooms, which are thick and heavy to ensure maximum privacy, feature a push opening that simulates a jewel vault, a reminder that every guest is precious and deserves protection, and an example of Bvlgari's constant attention to detail. The creative heritage of the Roman Maison shines also through the marvelous sketches of Bvlgari's historic jewels, such as the famous "Giardinetto" brooches from the 1950s, which decorate the walls of the corridors and rooms.

## THE ROOMS

The rooms represent the ultimate expression of Made in Italy furnishings. Equipped with a large walk-in closet, they offer guests a comfortable king size bed (193 x 203 cm) or two queen-size beds (152 x 203 cm), and a bathroom in matt black Zimbabwean granite, with a separate shower, which creates a contrasting effect with the elements in white Navona travertine.

### THE SUITES

The suites represent the ideal solution for long-term stays, each with its distinctive characteristics and special touches that make it unique. Graced by a splendid view of the garden, the suites unfold in a sequence of spacious rooms that include a living room, a bedroom with walk-in closet and a bright bathroom, covered in white Navona travertine, which houses a large bathtub and a separate roomy shower.

To ensure the utmost privacy, the spaces are separated by bronze mesh screens positioned between the oak walls and cream-colored linen tapestry. The luxurious 120-sqm Premium Suites feature floor-to-ceiling windows overlooking the adjacent Botanical Garden. The large living room with dining area can accommodate up to six people.

### THE BVLGARI SUITE

Located on the top floor of the hotel, the over 250 sqm Bvlgari Suite features two bedrooms as well as a private roof garden of 100 sqm. This quiet haven right in the heart of Milan offers a unique view of the Botanical Gardens and the historic center of the city.

Curated by architect Flaviano Capriotti, the design of the Bvlgari Suite is contemporary and timeless. B&B modular bookcases showcase a rare collection of art and design books, while unique pieces of furniture from Antonio Citterio's Flexform and Maxalto collections create an environment of discreet luxury. Custom curtains and headboards displaying Bvlgari's eight-pointed star motif, created by Enzo degli Angiuoni, add a touch of elegance.

Framed pictures of emblematic views of Milan, works by the artist Irene Kung, a Murano glass ceiling chandelier from the 1960s by Archimede Seguso and soft carpets by Altai enrich the interiors, enhancing the welcoming and refined atmosphere with a sense of place.

The Bvlgari Suite includes two bedrooms, a living room and a private roof garden with 360-degree views of Milan's skyline. The outdoor space, complete with all services and equipped with lawn chairs and a full dining area surrounded by lush vegetation, is ideal for relaxing both during the day and in the evening.

The Bvlgari Suite master bedroom features an elegant walk-in closet and a large bathroom with vanity desk, steam shower, and a bathtub made from a 900 kg block of Brera stone which, due to its size, was brought into the suite via crane, before even installing the room's windows. The second bedroom accommodates a double or twin bed option, is equipped with a walk-in closet and offers views of the city from both its bedroom and large bathroom.

The spacious living room, defined by teak finishing and floor-to-ceiling windows, is furnished as a private residence with a beautiful bookcase and a fireplace that serves both the inside and the

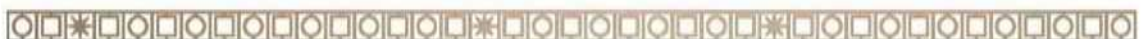
outside balcony and terrace. The Suite also includes a private kitchen along with a dining area that can accommodate up to eight people.

The Bvlgari Suite can also be reserved for private dinners.

### BESPOKE SERVICES

Upon arrival and departure, guests can request the suitcase packing or unpacking service. #### THE CONCEPT

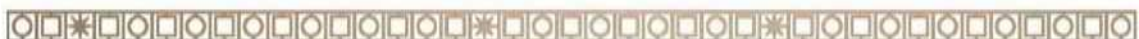
The Bvlgari Hotel Milano has welcomed the quintessence of Italian cuisine. It has arrived under the signature of Niko Romito - one of the world's most celebrated chefs with three Michelin stars for his Reale restaurant in Abruzzo and curator of the restaurants of the Bvlgari Hotels in Beijing, Shanghai, Dubai, Paris, Tokyo and Rome – who from 27 August 2018 expresses his own art of taste at the Bvlgari Hotel Milano.

Contemporary Italian cuisine is at the heart of Chef Niko's new concept. He spent two years studying traditional techniques and ingredients in order to create, expressly for the Bvlgari Hotels & Resorts, a culinary canon incorporating modernity and tradition, where every element expresses the most authentic essence of Made in Italy. The leading role is played by taste, which Romito considers to be an absolute value and, as such, something everyone can relate to.

The entire menu was conceived as a reinterpretation of the great classics of the Italian tradition in a philologically correct way, not just in terms of ingredients and recipes, but also in their presentation and service. A gastronomic grand tour of the best of Italy, as well as an exclusive and complete experience of what Italian cuisine is today according to the Chef.

This commitment to refining traditional procedures, in search of a new and ingenious archetype that best expresses Italian culture, allows guests to undertake an exceptional journey into Italy's unique flavors. The culinary itinerary includes some of Chef Niko's signature dishes, such as the Antipasto all'Italiana, an original starter that encompasses the specialties of all the Italian regions in one dish, and recodified versions of iconic classics such as Lasagna, Veal Milanese, Potato Ravioli with Red Prawns, and Tiramisù.

The restaurant, which can accommodate up to 80 people, provides an additional treat to the guest's stay but is also open to the public, who are invited to taste the most authentic Italian cuisine. Open for lunch and dinner, the restaurant boasts an elegant yet relaxed style, creating a refined and informal atmosphere. Outdoor dining overlooking the hotel's private garden is available throughout spring and summer. Dishes can be ordered à la carte or from the sharing menu, which is created for all the table guests. For Chef Niko Romito, food is an all-round experience, which extends well beyond what is on the plate. It hinges on the atmosphere, on the attention to detail, on elegance and especially on comfort. The atmosphere of the Bvlgari Hotels also permeates the Il Ristorante - Niko Romito through its authentic Italian flavors and iconic dishes, and a service that encourages conviviality and tells the story of the great Italian gastronomic tradition.

### IL GIARDINO AND IL BAR

The Bvlgari Hotel Milano has become not only a point of reference for in-house guests but also the place-to-be for the city's inhabitants.

This is also thanks to the wonderful garden - the only one of its kind among the Bvlgari Hotels & Resorts properties in the world – which is ideal for hosting outdoor cocktail parties and receptions during the summer, or simply for taking refuge into an oasis of tranquility in the historic center of the city.

#### IL GIARDINO

Designed like an open-air suite, Il Giardino, Italian for garden, is an integral part of the Hotel's soul which is composed of four spaces: the Vimini Area, the five Isole di Ghiaia, the Gazebo and the outdoor Bar. The Hotel also offers the option to reserve the outdoor Bar with the Isole di Ghiaia for private events.

#### IL BAR

In each Bvlgari Hotels & Resorts, the cocktail bar is dominated by a large dominant counter, made of a different material depending on the location. In Milan, the choice fell on black resin, which contrasts the brightness of the spectacular glass wall, a prelude to the quiet of the garden. The cocktail hour, from 6.30pm to 9pm, has become an unmissable event, where to enjoy the classic Italian aperitivo with a wide selection of traditional and innovative drinks such as the Bvlgari Specials. Among these, the exclusive Signature Bvlgari Cocktail represents a real must in the bars of the hospitality collection, based on Gin, Aperol, lime juice, pineapple juice and freshly squeezed orange juice.

The full restaurant menu is also served at the bar, but in a more informal style. Smokers find a safe haven in the Cigar room, where they can relax while tasting one of the whiskeys from the Rare Collection: Macallan 1967, Port Ellen 16th Release 37 years and Ardbeg Twenty Something. In addition to spirits, the bar offers a refined choice of leaf teas and herbal teas, which are also served in lounge from 3.30pm to 6.30pm, accompanied by a tray of fine pastries.

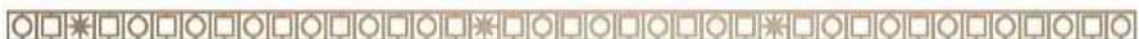
### IL GAZEBO

Nestled in a private corner of the garden there is another marvelous space, Il Gazebo, which offers the opportunity to enjoy a special dining experience. Hidden behind a dense hedge of red beech trees, Il Gazebo is the ideal place for hosting private lunches and dinners, in total privacy. The menu curated by Niko Romito is served à la française on Richard Ginori porcelain, contributing to making Il Gazebo one of the most charming and exclusive outdoor spaces in Milan.

This enchanting place also hides a detail that few have the privilege of knowing: upon exiting Il Gazebo, surrounded by vegetation, guests can admire a Madonnina, symbol of the city of Milan. This statue, originally preserved in the church where the Bvlgari Hotel Milano's restaurant stands today, symbolizes the deep connection with the origins of the historic building.

### THE LOUNGE

The black granite from Zimbabwe, the fireplace, the books, the seasonal delicacies, the sweets, the candles, the images portraying iconic divas such as Monica Vitti, Sophia Loren and Anita Ekberg, who over the years have passionately worn Bvlgari jewelry. With its tall windows, the lobby is the perfect setting to talk or relax in an elegant yet informal environment.

A hair washing station is separated by a brass mesh screen: an interlude of classic style, rich in material effect, which embraces the space and offers privacy with its curvilinear design.

Technical and soft lights are integrated into the environment to create an atmosphere of comfort and relaxation, allowing guests to rediscover that sense of pleasant indulgence and the real essence of a time for oneself.
